

Master guitarist-singer-songwriter Brooks Williams released his first album early in 1990. The Washington *Post* wrote a glowing review which prompted National Public Radio's invitation for Williams to appear on *All Things Considered* with Noah Adams. And that's where it all began. The tours followed and so did the albums. Counting the new one, he has done twenty-nine in all and has never looked back.

A Statesboro, Georgia native now living in England, Brooks Williams seamlessly brings together Americana and country blues in a style that is unmistakably his own. A flashy fingerpicker, soaring bottleneck slide

For his 30th Anniversary Tour, Williams has recorded an album of his favorite songs from his back catalogue. Called Work My Claim, the songs reach across the span of years and are as relevant now as they were when released.

Williams is a consummate artist, performing hundreds of shows every year and recording at a dizzying pace. WUMB-Boston named him one of their Top 100 All-Time Artists. He's also listed in the Top 100 Acoustic Guitarists. Brooks' Blues (2017) is listed in Down at The Crossroads' Top 20 Blues Albums of All-Time.

The Folk Club membership has been \$15 a year for some time now. One of our members asked Dave Hurd to consider a lifetime membership option. He and Ben thought about it but didn't think it would be very popular. However, we decided to try a discounted multi-year membership. We think it will benefit members who might forget to renew on time - and also those volunteers who maintain the member list (guess who? Ben and Dave). So for a trial period – until the end of May – current, renewing, and new members can renew or join for 5 years for \$55 (the Five for Fifty-Five plan) if they wish. Most Tuesday nights the Folk Club is an open-mike format with a signup board. Each performer has 12 minutes, which includes setup time.

SHOWCASE PERFORMANCES

On the 2nd Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 25-minute performance. To be in the Showcase you must: 1) be a Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 6 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) Win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!
