Keeping Our Music Community Alive

The first official Folk Club Virtual Open Mic was held online on April 7th. Folk Club members used their web-connected audio/video devices and the Zoom app to share songs. The Zoom session was streamed to YouTube Live, which anyone can watch while entering and viewing each other's comments. Everyone agrees it is great to see and hear the musicians from their living spaces, and even though we can't be together, it connects us and strengthens the bond between us.


As of this writing we have had four virtual open mics and they are enjoyed by both musicians and listeners who love music. Since only members can play we have more performers joining our club. And we are getting better at it, learning from each other the best way to do things, and having fun with the capabilities that the technology allows.

It works like this: Over the weekend a notice is sent to all members with a reminder about the next virtual open mic on Tuesday night from 7:30 to 10:00 (if you have not received this notice, we probably don't have your email address – please send it to newsletter@restonherndonfolkclub.com). Members who want to play have until Tuesday at noon to sign up via email. On Tuesday afternoon the Zoom meeting invitation is sent to those who signed up. An emcee is designated, musicians join Zoom after 7 PM, and listeners get on YouTube to watch and listen. And then magic happens.

If you haven't joined us yet for one of the virtual open mics, please check it out. Go to our website (<u>www.restonherndonfolkclub.com</u>), select Calendar (upper right on banner), select Virtual Open Mic under a date, and then select the YouTube link after Description. If it's Tuesday between 7:30 and 10 PM you can watch live, for earlier dates you can see the replay.

Until we can meet again at the Amphora, the Folk Club virtual open mic is the best way to help us maintain a sense of community with each other in spite of our separation, and to weather through this together. As Ellen Kaminsky said, it's

Most Tuesday nights the Folk Club is an open-mike format with a signup board. Each performer has 12 minutes, which includes setup time.

SHOWCASE PERFORMANCES

On the 2nd Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 25-minute performance. To be in the Showcase you must: 1) be a Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 6 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) Win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!

Folk Club members are encouraged to submit performance calendars, classified ads, articles, reviews, and other music-related items for the newsletter.
