In memory of his military service, a military Honor Guard is planned for 2 PM with a formal presentation of his interment flag.

This is our opportunity to say goodbye to Dave, for 35 years the heart and soul of The Folk Club of Reston-Herndon, whose music gatherings were legendary.

# A Folk Club Theme Night Country Songs

Tuesday, August 11, 2020, Online

We're continuing our summer theme nights (when we don't schedule concerts) this month. The suggested musical theme gives performers incentive to research a genre of music and to come up with songs which follow the theme and interpret them in their own style. We decided it would be fun to do it again this year for the virtual open mic. We picked a theme for August and the challenge is on:

# All songs should be "Country" songs

Country Music, or Country and Western, is a genre that takes its roots from genres such as blues and old-time music, and various types of American folk music including Appalachian, Cajun, and the cowboy Western music styles of Red Dirt, New Mexico, Texas country, and Tejano. Its popularized roots originate in the Southern United States of the early 1920s.

Country music often consists of ballads and dance tunes with generally simple forms, folk lyrics, and vocal harmonies, mostly accompanied by string instruments such as banjos, acoustic guitars, steel guitars (such as pedal steels and dobros), and fiddles, as well as harmonicas.

Some of the more famous country music performers are Hank Williams, Jimmie Rodgers, Roy Acuff, Eddy Arnold, Jim Reeves, Bob Wills, Gene Autry, Bill Monroe, The Carter Family, Patsy Cline, Chet Atkins, Minnie Pearl, Kitty Wells, Merle Travis, Johnny Cash, Flatt & Scruggs, Roy Rogers, Loretta Lynn, Tennessee Ernie Ford, George Jones, Willie Nelson, Merle Haggard, Roger Miller, Buck Owens, Brenda Lee, Tammy Wynette, Dolly Parton, Charley Pride, Waylon Jennings, Bill Anderson, Kris Kristofferson, Glen Campbell, Alabama, George Strait, Vince Gill, The Statler Brothers, Emmylou Harris, Tom T Hall, Roy Clark, Reba McEntire, Garth Brooks, Kenny Rodgers, Randy Travis, Charlie Daniels, Jerry Reed, Ricky Skaggs, etc., etc.

Most Tuesday nights the Folk Club is an open-mike format with a signup board. Each performer has 12 minutes, which includes setup time.

#### **SHOWCASE PERFORMANCES (on hold)**

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 25-minute performance. To be in the Showcase you must: 1) be a Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 6 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) Win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!
