Jeff Smith is a musical raconteur whose poetic lyrics paint common experiences and filtered memories with a tender and playful brush. Singing in a honey-drenched Appalachian drawl, multi-instrumental Smith lays down a brew of what he calls "a funky kind of country blues and pop rock stomp." These are songs that touch the heart and make you chuckle, shed a tear, dance, sing along or tap your toes. His songs have been featured on television shows such as "The Young and Restless", "Army Wives", and "Young Sheldon" and in a European ad campaign for Opel automobiles.

Sherry Stewart writes songs about people, places and things that have left an impression on her. Themes often evoke nature and leave the listener with a sense of longing only heightened by her angelic voice and vocal harmonies. Sherry was a founding member of The Stewart Sisters. Their CD "Another Place & Time" was recorded and engineered by Les Thompson, a founding member of the Nitty Gritty Dirt Band. Sherry plays guitar, mandolin, flute, and enjoys adding harmonies and accompaniment to various music ensembles.

FOLK CLUB INFORMATION

In-Person Open Mic Status

We have been having our Tuesday night meetings in-person at the Amphora since June 8th. Since then, the coronavirus has gotten progressively worse, especially since the end of July. On August 24th, after a vote by the board of directors, we put in place policies to help minimize the spread of the virus, with these requests: that only those who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 attend, that everyone (including those fully vaccinated) wear a face mask when not eating, drinking, or performing, and that anyone experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms (such as fever, chills, cough, runny nose, shortness of breath, or loss of taste or smell) not attend. We are doing this to help protect the health and safety of our members, guests, servers, and their friends and loved ones.

Return of Virtual Open Mics on Zoom

When we went back to our in-person open mics there were a number of folks who expressed an interest in continuing our virtual open mics. And there was some discussion of doing so on a trial basis, to see if attendance warranted continuing with them. Recently, there has been some renewed interest in revisiting this idea. So we are going to conduct a series of virtual open mics on EVERY OTHER Monday, starting September 13th, from 7:30 to 9:30 PM.

These will be conducted a little differently from the previous virtual open mics as there will be no YouTube broadcast of the Zoom session. Instead, anyone who only wishes to watch may join the Zoom session and keep their microphone muted and/or turn their camera off - but may participate in the chat to share the experience. We may or may not have an MC, depending on the interest, but will continue the "roundrobin" theme of one song each until the time runs out. Those interested in participating will send an email to Al Hobson at <u>alhobson@verizon.net</u> by Sunday evening in order to receive an invitation to join the Zoom Meeting Monday night. Please state if you wish to perform and be put on the "virtual signup board" or are just attending as an audience member. We will try this for two months to see what kind of interest we have. Here are the dates: September 13, September 27, October 11, and October 25. Note: These sessions are in addition to our Tuesday night in-person open mics at the Amphora, which will continue.
