Jim Thorne is a space scientist and singer/songwriter who hosts a nation-wide public-access TV show called "Space Quest with Dr. Jim" and provides educational story songs for the Smithsonian National Air & Space Museum. Jennifer Katt has been writing and performing music, individually and with others, since the early 80's. Following the breakup of her classic rock/pop cover band "Full House," she and two other members as well as frequent co-writers - Tomm Sibert and Janet Gerber-Salins - reformed as the trio "Bugleweed," performing their award-winning original tunes in three-part harmony with acoustic instrumentation.

After a successful run in the DC-area folk music circuit, Bugleweed succumbed to members' shifting life priorities, and Tomm and Jennifer once again found a new musical home with "Random Act," an 8-member high-harmony group featuring a lavish array of instruments and vocal arrangements (think "A Mighty Wind";-).

After half of Random Act moved to the West Coast and following some considerable downtime, Jennifer took to



writing and performing once again, sometimes with others but often as a solo singer-songwriter, enjoying the intimacy of smaller venues and songwriting circles. Her song themes often feature people who are important to her—aka tribute songs—some of which she plans to perform for this showcase. Jennifer will be joined by several family members and special guest stars who have graced the stage of the Amphora.

Jennifer is so grateful to be back with the Reston-Herndon Folk Club, which she frequents both as a performer and audience member. She is also a longtime member and past board member of the Songwriters Association of Washington (SAW) and has won several awards from SAW's Mid-Atlantic Song Contest. Jennifer sings each Sunday with the St. Paul United Methodist Church Choir and also with a Barbershop Quartet.

Erynn Marshall and Carl Jones are oldtime musicians and inspired tunesmiths from Galax, Virginia. They are married – in life and music. Southern song-duets and powerful fiddle, guitar, mandolin, banjo tunes comprise their diverse sets. This will be the duet's first appearance at The Folk Club.

Erynn is an old-time fiddler who lives in Galax, Virginia and is known internationally for her traditional music. She is coordinator for Swannanoa Old-Time Week near Asheville, NC.

Carl is an American songwriter and multiinstrumentalist. In the 1980's he played mandolin with James Bryan, Norman and Nancy Blake as part of the Rising Fawn String Ensemble.

On the 2nd Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 24-minute performance. To be in the Showcase you must: 1) be a Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 6 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) Win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!
