Gotta hear that guitar, too!



Chuck Pyle's charismatic voice and pumping guitar style combine seamlessly to make a dazzling kind of Southwestern Acoustic rock. His humorous looks into the humanity of us all say the things we've always thought and wished we'd said. A beloved performer, his Zen cowboy character illumines the mind and empowers the heart for one of life's quintessential feel-good moments. Chuck has lived on the front-range of Colorado for over 30 years and spent most of that time traveling the country playing theaters, festivals, colleges and coffeehouses. He has nine albums to his credit and a locally well-known theme song he composed for the 13-part PBS series, Spirit Of Colorado, beamed worldwide by satellite.

Though better known as a performing songwriter whose songs have been recorded by Jerry Jeff Walker, John Denver, The Nitty Gritty Dirt Band, Suzy Bogguss and Chris LeDoux, Chuck has also developed a reputation as a powerful, push-the-envelope guitar stylist, and has taught guitar seminars at such prestigious events as the Puget Sound Guitar Workshop. Chuck is also one of the more popular performers on the singer-songwriter circuit. He is a regular at the Kerrville Folk Festival, and his song Every Day Now was nominated as best song at the prestigious Kerrville Music Awards. He was part of Christine Lavin's Songwriter retreat in Martha's Vineyard that included David Wilcox, Patty Larkin, Pierce Pettis, Cheryl Wheeler, and Cliff Eberhardt. He premiered a **one-man theater** piece called Zen Gallon Hat (A One-Fact Play) in December '96. Pyle has nine albums to his credit, including a live album Romancing the Moment released in 2005 and *True Unity* a new studio album recorded at Boulder's nationally-prominent Coupe Studios. *True Unity* is a satisfying collection of swing, folk, Cajun & pop, all sprinkled with Pyle's intelligent lyrics. Guests on the CD include daughter Carlene Carter, stepdaughter Rosanne Cash, and many of June Carter Cash's friends and admirers, such as Sheryl Crow, Willie Nelson, Ronnie Dunn, Loretta Lynn, Patty Loveless, Kris Kristofferson, Brad Paisley, Elvis Costello, Billy Bob Thornton, Billy Joe Shaver, Ralph Stanley, and Emmylou Harris.

New Release Of Lomax Spanish Recordings

A new album of Lomax recordings, *Mallorca: The Balearic Islands*, will be released on March 20. The album is based on the recordings Lomax made during a 6-month trip through Spain that started with the 1952 Palma Folklore Festival in Mallorca. From the music of the Festival, he went on to record the island's ancient threshing and olive picking songs, friction drumming, and shepherd tunes.

Anna Lomax Wood (Lomax's daughter and the producer of the Alan Lomax Collection) and Spanish Recordings editor Judith Cohen recently visited Mallorca, Ibiza, and Formentera, where they presented the album to audiences. Several of the original artists from 1952 were present during the events.
