Folk Club Format

On most Tuesday evenings, the Folk Club is an open mike format with a sign-up board. Each performer has 12 minutes, including setup time. This allows three songs if you set up FAST and the songs are of moderate length.

Showcase Performances

On the second Tuesday of each month, we feature a Folk Club member in a two set (25-minute) "Showcase" performance. To be in a showcase you have to:

- be a Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in 6 months.
- fill out a lottery slip any time in the month before the drawing
- win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase
- prepare to be featured in the next newsletter!

Folk Club members may submit performance calendars, classified advertisements, articles, reviews, artwork and other items to Carol Deakin at cd7158@erols.com. All items must relate to music and be emailed in WordPerfect. Information must be received one week before the first day of the month in which you want it published. Items will be printed on the basis of music related interest, timeliness and space available with club information being the first priority.

Step Right Up!

Your volunteer time and talent is needed in the following Folk Club positions.

- 1. Publicity Chair: Process already in place (Lynn Jordon will be happy to train and will provide all files/contacts). Duties include writing press releases and Public Service Announcements for newspapers, newsletters, and radio broadcast. These are all mailed (snail or email) to the existing list of contacts about one month prior to the event (some newsletters require a little more notice).
- 2. Folk Club Phone Contact: This entails making a phone number available for the public to contact the Folk Club (i.e. "for info, call....") and simply means having an answering machine with a "You've reached the Folk Club" type of message, checking it for messages, and returning phone calls. Again, Lynn Jordon has been providing this service and can give tips.
- 3. **President:** We're looking for one good (woman, man, folkie) to lead us. Feel up to the challenge? Not much work, very little pay (actually, none at all), but the crown is real pretty. Larry promised to have the stains removed before turning it over.....
- 4. Secretary: This job entails taking the minutes at our bi-annual Board Meeting and then bringing them to the next meeting. We really only do this so we don't forget from meeting-to-meeting what we talked about. We have meetings whenever there is an urgent need. Although 'bi-annual' should mean 'twice each year,' we average about one every other year. After fourteen years, we don't have all that much 'urgent' stuff.
