June 14 Showcase – Jennifer Katt

Jennifer Katt has been writing and performing music, individually and with others, since the early 80's. Following the breakup of the classic rock/pop cover band "Full House," she and two other members and frequent co-writers - Tomm Sibert and Janet Gerber-Salins - reformed as the trio "Bugleweed," performing their award-winning original tunes in three-part harmony with acoustic instrumentation.

After a successful run in the DC-area folk music circuit, Bugleweed succumbed to members' shifting life priorities, and Tomm and Jennifer once again found a new musical home with "Random Act," an 8-member high-harmony group featuring a lavish array of instruments and vocal arrangements (think "A Mighty Wind" 😊).

After half of Random Act moved to the West Coast and following some considerable downtime, Jennifer took to writing and performing once again, sometimes with others but often as a solo singer-songwriter, enjoying the intimacy of smaller venues and songwriting circles. Her song themes often feature people who are important to her—aka tribute songs—some of which she plans to perform for this showcase. Jennifer will be joined by Tomm Sibert and their musician son Samm, plus other special guests who have graced the stage of the Amphora.

Jennifer is so grateful to be back with the Reston-Herndon Folk Club, which she frequents both as a performer and audience member. She is also a longtime member and past board member of the Songwriters Association of Washington (SAW) and has won several awards from SAW's Mid-Atlantic Song Contest. Jennifer sings each Sunday with the St. Paul United Methodist Church Choir and also with a Barbershop Quartet.

The Furnace Mountain Trio makes up 3/4 of The Furnace Mountain Band and consists of Aimee Curl on bass and vocals, Dave Van Deventer on fiddle and vocals, and Morgan Morrison on guitar, bouzouki.

They've performed throughout the world, from the Yangtze River in China to the banks of the Shenandoah River, where they are the host band of the Watermelon Pickers' Festival. The trio plays music from the American Appalachian traditions, as well as

original compositions, and songs penned by their favorite song writing friends.

The band creates music that is at times lively and raucous, with spirited fiddle melodies weaving in and around the powerful rhythms of the bass and bouzouki, and other times poignant and poetic, with sublime vocal harmonies beautifully interpreting some of the oldest songs ever written.

SHOWCASE PERFORMANCES

On the 2nd Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 24-minute performance. To do a Showcase you must: 1) be a paid-up Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 12 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!
