### January 10 Showcase – Carolyn Eyerly

Carolyn Eyerly is honored to be a new member to the Folk Club of Reston & Herndon. "I'm impressed by the warm, welcoming community I've met here since I began attending this Fall. I'm excited to perform in the January showcase with my new duo partner, Max Garrison."

Carolyn Eyerly is a singer, songwriter, and rhythm guitarist who grew up in Northern Virginia listening to Southern Rock and Bluegrass music. Carolyn is a graduate of the National Conservatory of Dramatic Arts and anticipated returning to acting after her children had grown but found music to be an overwhelming draw.

In 2010, Carolyn was a founding vocalist for the acclaimed Washington, D.C.-based folk group, Shenandoah Run. After discovering the warm community which is bluegrass music Carolyn became a founding member of Sweet Yonder, an all-women bluegrass band, in 2014. In 2019 Sweet Yonder was nominated for a Washington Area Music Association WAMMIE Award in two categories, Best Bluegrass Band and Best Bluegrass Album. Carolyn's first solo project, **The Sunny Side Of Life**, released in 2021, includes seven of her original compositions.

Carolyn was awarded the 2022 WAMMIE Award for Best Bluegrass Artist/Group.

Carolyn's duo partner, Massimo (Max) Garrison, grew up in South Carolina where he fell in love with bluegrass music and began teaching himself the bluegrass flatpicking guitar style at the age of 13. As a lover of all styles of music he furthered his education as a jazz studies major, with a focus on upright bass performance at USC.

Max later moved to Washington DC where he quickly found his musical skills to be in high demand and began working full-time backing up bands in the studio and on live performances all over the United States, Fiji, and China. Max has recorded or performed with Bob Perilla and the Big Hillbilly Bluegrass Band, The Eastman String Band, Frank Solivan and Dirty Kitchen, The U-Liners, Avril Smith, Becky Warren and the Great Unknowns, Frank Wakefield, Tom Mindte and the Patuxent Partners, Jon Glik, Only Lonesome, Lester Chambers, Esther Haynes and Hokum Jazz, META, Town Mountain, Richard Greene, David Grier, and others.

#### **SHOWCASE PERFORMANCES**

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 24-minute performance. To do a Showcase you must: 1) be a paid-up Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 12 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!
