November 7 Showcase – Rich Battaglia

Rich is very excited to be doing his second Folk Club Showcase since joining in 2021. His first was in July 2022 and they're letting him do it again, so that's a good sign.

He is delighted to be joined by some outstanding folk club musicians:

Jennifer Katt – A natural musician and excellent songwriter, she is an outstanding performer who gives her whole heart every time she performs. And, she has a lovely voice. Her showcase in September was such a musical feast that people gave her a standing ovation at the end.

Joe Shade – As is said (by me!) every time Joe performs, "Let There Be Shade!" Joe has an extensive catalog of songs he has written and recorded over his 20-year performing career, and has only accelerated his creativity by continuing to crank out new bombshell numbers since he's joined Folk Club. He's playing lead guitar tonight and has permission to go wherever the music takes him. Let There Be Shade.

Jim Fowler – Jim is one of the most complete and powerful performers in the Folk Club. He has done so much in his musical career it is hard to summarize here. He's playing bass guitar tonight, but he also happens to be one of the finest fingerstyle guitar players around (watch out Leo Kottke!). He has written and recorded many albums, sings and harmonizes, and plays some mean harmonica.

Ron Goad – Ron is not only an excellent percussionist in so many styles, he is that rarity among drummers - he sings excellent harmonies and can be called upon to do great lead singing as well. He is an anchor for the Folk Club and has so many awards in music promotion and songwriting it would be overwhelming to point them out here. The hardest working

man in Folk/Rock in Virginia (and Maryland!).

Cindy McConnell – Cindy was on hiatus from the Folk Club for a number of years, but is back in full swing. Cindy is an intuitive singer and is so nice to listen to. So happy to have her singing with us tonight, although we all know she'd rather be riding Tennessee Gent out in the woods.

Rich Battaglia – What can be said about Rich that hasn't already been said? He has not been convicted of any felonies and has no outstanding indictments (in the U.S.). Having found a home at the Folk Club, he wants to be extra careful not to blow it here with some new information.

Rupert Wates was born in London and studied at Oxford University. He has been a full-time songwriter since the late 1990s, when he signed a publishing contract with Eaton Music Limited. In London he worked with some of the best performers in the city. Moving in 2001 to Paris, Wates formed his own quartet and began playing live regularly. In fall 2006 he came to the US. He is now based in New York City and Colorado. Since coming to the US, he has won more than 50 songwriting and performing awards.

His music is an eclectic mix of acoustic, melodic art/folk, with flavors of jazz, vaudeville and cabaret. He has released twelve solo CDs. They have received outstanding reviews in the international online press and tracks from them have been played on radio all over the world. In addition, Wates'

songs have been covered by other artists in the UK, Canada and the US. Two full length tribute CDs to his material have been recorded: 'Crazy Puzzle' (2015) by Nashville-based performer Roxie Rogers, and 'Wide Open Heart' (July 2017) by Los Angeles vocalist Susan Kohler. Both these CDs were initiated and funded entirely by the artists themselves, and are comprised exclusively of songs from Wates' back catalog.

Despite Wates' British background, and underpinning the universality of his music's appeal, Folk and Acoustic Music Exchange has called him "a prime figure in American music" and goes on: "This is one gifted sonofabitch... If you're not hip to this guy yet you're missing out."

Most Tuesday nights the Folk Club is an open-mike format with a signup board. Each performer has 8 minutes, which includes setup time.

SHOWCASE PERFORMANCES

On the 2nd Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 24-minute performance. To do a Showcase you must: 1) be a paid-up Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 12 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!
