As a rural Pennsylvania teenager in the 70s, I listened to vinyl folk and what's now classic rock albums such as Carly Simon's *No Secrets* and Fleetwood Mac's *Rumours*. I sang in my high school varsity chorus and performed in musicals; a favorite role was Liesl in *The Sound of Music*. I also learned a few guitar chords along the way.

During college, I joined some musician friends occasionally for some dive bar gigs in Maryland and West Virginia. Later, as a single mom trying to progress in my career, I didn't have much time to perform music again until my son went off to college in 2002. Then, with more free time on my hands, I bought a nicer guitar — my first Martin — and a sound system, and started performing at an annual Labor Day weekend event in my hometown, and frequently in Virginia coffee shops, bars, and wineries, mostly solo but at times with a few others. I also performed for more than a decade at an annual Finger Lakes (New York) greyhound adoption fundraiser.

I cover a wide range of folk as well as classic and progressive rock artists; just a few of many influences (in addition to Carly and Stevie Nicks) include Bob Dylan, Cat Stevens, Christine Kane, Elton John, John Prine, Joni

Mitchell, Kasey Musgraves, Neil Young, Sheryl Crow, and Tracy Chapman. I've slowly started to work on some originals, too. More to come on that front!

My day job is communicating about evidence-based biomedical science. I also love spending time with my horse and greyhound, and hanging out with human friends and family, too, including two granddaughters. I love this country despite its many flaws so continue to closely follow and advocate against the rising fascism.

While I performed at the Folk Club just a few times before 2023, including at the Tortilla Factory, I've become a regular since last year and am grateful for so many new, wonderful friends, some of whom will be joining my showcase: the fabulous Sherry Stewart, Jen Katt, John Druitt, and Ron Goad!

Looking forward to August 13 and to many more fun Folk Club Tuesday nights ahead!

Performers, pick out songs from your favorite female songwriters (they can be co-writes with men too), and join us on August 20th! Listeners, come and enjoy the songs they've picked to share. It's a safe bet that some will be familiar favorites and others will be enjoyable discoveries.







Note: The theme nights have been going since 2016, and they are fun and often result in surprising song choices. They're an opportunity to try something a little different and have a good time with it. We encourage performers to play songs that fit the theme. Of course, that doesn't mean it's required: anyone who signs up on a theme night can play whatever they want, and that will be fine, too. But everyone will appreciate those who find fitting tunes to share.

Most Tuesday nights the Folk Club is an open-mike format with a signup board. Each performer has 8 minutes, which includes setup time.

SHOWCASE PERFORMANCES

On the 2nd Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 24-minute performance. To do a Showcase you must: 1) be a paid-up Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 12 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!
