June 10 Showcase – Ryan Murphy by Ryan

A member of the Folk Club for the past three years, Ryan has been working on songwriting since

joining. These efforts have resulted in introspective songs utilizing novel finger-picking patterns on acoustic guitar, and a vocal style reminiscent of the alternative rock and grunge music he grew up listening to. That style now falls somewhere between Cat Stevens and Dermott Kennedy. Ryan also plays bass with a classic-rock cover band called Center Point, the Band. Picking up the bass influenced his style largely in the past year with more intricate bass-lines and picking patterns overall.

Over the past six months Ryan has been working on recording his first album for release, tentatively titled The River, under the name Ryan Wake. This album will feature two cover songs, You Are So Beautiful, originally written



by Billy Preston and popularized by Joe Cocker, and The Freshmen, by The Verve Pipe, as well as eight original songs.

Growing up, Ryan's love of music was nurtured earlier than he can remember by his father, who sang classic country and folk songs at bedtime, and his mother, who had him sitting in a stroller while she taught aerobics classes to the latest pop music of the 1980s. As he grew up, the diversity of musical influences only increased as he listened to his parents' records of Simon and Garfunkel, Gordon Lightfoot, and Led Zepplin, bought cassettes of Weird Al Yankovic, and then CDs of Bush, Soundgarden, The Offspring, and Tool. Many of these artists were storytellers in their songs, which influenced Ryan's songwriting about his own life. Outside of music, Ryan is a psychologist who works to make sure that patients in clinical trials for new treatments are presented with questionnaires they understand, and which address what is important to them about their condition. He also enjoys meditation, trivia nights, and assembling wrist-watches.

Ryan has enjoyed serving as an MC for the Folk Club, listening to all of the incredibly talented members and performers, and playing whenever possible for the past three years. He is grateful for the welcoming atmosphere every Tuesday night, it's an honor to play for people who care so deeply about music and songwriting.

Folk Club Theme Night – Tuesday, June 17th "Sweet Summer Nights"



On the 2nd Tuesday of the month (usually), we feature a "Showcase" of a Folk Club member in a 24-minute performance. To do a Showcase you must: 1) be a paid-up Folk Club member who has not done a showcase in the last 12 months; 2) fill out a lottery slip and place it in the "drawing bucket"; 3) win the drawing on the night of the current month's showcase; and 4) be prepared to be featured in the next newsletter!
